

RULES OF ENTRY

The show is open to all UK born Pedigree Registered calves born on or after 1st July 2021.

The classification will be decided and sub-divided into appropriate age groups after the entries have closed, and classes will be provided for the following: -

Class 1	Male Calf born between 01/07/21 and 30/09/21
Class 2	Male Calf born between 01/10/21 and 31/12/21
Class 3	Male Calf born between 01/01/22 and 31/03/22
Class 4	Male Calf born between 01/04/22 and 30/09/22
Class 5	Female Calf born between 01/07/21 and 30/09/21
Class 6	Female Calf born between 01/10/21 and 31/12/21
Class 7	Female Calf born between 01/01/22 and 31/03/22
Class 8	Female Calf born between 01/04/22 and 30/09/22
Class 9	Young Handler (aged 16 and under)
Class 10	Progeny Group (2 Animals by the same sire but out of different dams)

Rosettes will be awarded to the animals standing 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th in each class and a championship sash will be awarded to the supreme champion calf.

All pedigree registered British Blue bulls and females must be entered and registered in the herd book of the British Blue cattle society, and is open to all members of the society.

Entry Fees

The entry fee of £20 + VAT per animal MUST BE SUBMITTED, with all entries, otherwise the entry will be refused. Calves entered for classes '9 & 10' free if entered in classes 1-8.

ENTRY FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE

The show is open to all members of the British Blue Cattle Society.

No animal(s) will be accepted for entry if they do not have a British Herd Book Number.

MALE CHAMPION CALF

The male champion calf will be awarded the Ryder Farming Perpetual Trophy and special rosette

FEMALE CHAMPION CALF

The female champion calf will be awarded the Bellas Perpetual Trophy and special rosette

OVERALL CHAMPION CALF

The champion calf will be awarded £150 and the David Dickinson Memorial Trophy, Special Rosette and Sash

RESERVE OVERALL CHAMPION CALF

The reserve champion calf will be awarded £75 and special rosette

BREEDER POINTS

The breeder with the most points will be awarded a Plaque from Norbreck genetics
